


# Niger Delta Weekly Conflict Update

February 15-21, 2026



This update highlights corporate–community tensions in Delta State, focusing on agitations against oil companies over infrastructure gaps, welfare concerns, and perceived neglect in host communities. These grievances have led to protests and operational disruptions, posing risks to industrial activities and corporate–community relations.

### Trends and Dynamics of Corporate-Community Tensions in Delta State



### Anticipated Trends and Dynamics

Ongoing grievances over welfare and perceived neglect may sustain corporate–community tensions. Without constructive engagement, they could escalate into further protests and disruptions, undermining operations and trust between companies and host communities.

### Actions Taken to Mitigate the Situation

Stakeholders have leveraged the Warri Multi-Stakeholder Platform (Warri-MSP) to ease tensions. However, targeted interventions are needed to improve awareness of CSR initiatives under the HCDTs and address perception gaps and misinformation in host communities.
